Camp Erin

August 6, 7, & 8, 2010

Camp Erin is a weekend bereavement camp for children ages 6 to 17 who have experienced the death of a loved one. The camp provides a safe, caring environment and offers fun recreational activities and supportive discussions to help children build trust, self-esteem and coping skills. Age appropriate groups provide an opportunity for children to interact with peers also dealing with the death of a loved one. Planned activities, discussions and remembrance ceremonies create a safe environment for sharing, having fun and making friends. Specially trained hospice staff and volunteers lead art therapy, recreational activities and grief workshops.

Camp Erin will take place at Cathedral Camp in East Freetown, MA. The camp is provided free of charge for up to 50 children between the ages of 6 and 17.
